

What is Moodle?



Moodle is a learning management system (LMS) designed to facilitate online education and training. It is a platform where educators can create, manage, and deliver courses, while learners can access resources, participate in activities, and interact with instructors and fellow students.

The BlueRev Support Tool uses Moodle as a base, and as such is able to make use of its flexibility, having access to a vast array of tools and activities!



Signing in

- Profile picture




Logging in


Navigating the Support Tool

Navigation menu




Clicking on the BlueRev Logo, you are directed to the User Dashboard, same as when you click **Dashboard**.

Community opens the platform's Social Feed, a shared forum






Side menu

Shows all new notifications. Clicking on the gear on the right opens the notifications preferences, where you can choose what notifications you wish to receive and where, between the Moodle platform and via email.

Partner Courses



Each Project Partner can manage their own courses, that can be available to all members of the platform, or specific groups of people.

Users can access the courses they are enrolled in, and view and interact with the contents therein.



Creating a new Course



Course Creation is handled by the platform administration, and the courses are managed by Project Partners.

Email <u>support@bluerevproject.eu</u> with the request to create a new course, along with the course name and a general description of the contents that are meant to be added.

Soon, you will be given access to a hidden course with a generic structure.

The items in the list-type pages are organised in a series of cards with relevant information listed (title, cover image, language, date and author).

You can customise how you organise the list, deciding how many you want to show per page, and how you want to sort them, and make general searches using the Search field.
